SUPPLY LIST

Students should bring to class the following:

- Water container, white ceramic or plastic
- Water color paint set (the inexpensive ones for kids are fine to start)
- Paper towels
- White plates, small, for mixing colors
- Newspaper (flat and clean), or piece of felt (1 yard) square, in black or dark blue to be used under your rice paper
- Chinese brushes (one large, one small), rice paper, liquid ink and ink stone.
Instructor will have limited supplies for purchase.

Suggested sources:

- House of Rice Oriental Imports & Gifts, 338 Broadway in Chico, has rice paper, inexpensive brushes and liquid Chinese or Japanese ink.
- Aaron Brothers has best selection of watercolor sets. There is one just for Chinese painting with limited colors.
- Kmart has white ceramic plates and bowls perfect for water containers and paint mixing. Plastic ones are fine for class and lighter to carry around.
