to **PRPD**. Those paying by mail & desiring a
confirmation/receipt include a Self Addressed
Stamped Envelope.

REFUNDS: CANCELLATIONS must be made
by 5 p.m. Friday, April 5, 2024. **No refunds will
be given after that time.** The event will be held
rain or shine.

PRE-REGISTRATION: Last year's participants
may pre-register by submitting a completed
application and fees before 5:00pm, Friday,
February 23, 2024.

OPEN REGISTRATION: Will begin
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2024, and will
continue to be accepted at the Paradise Recreation
Center, 6626 Skyway until 5:00pm, Thursday,
April 18, 2024, provided there is space available.

SELLER'S PERMIT: The California Board of
Equalization requires us to send them your seller's
permit number prior to the Faire. Be sure to list
your permit number on your application. For those
needing further information, call (800) 400-7115.

FOOD BOOTHS are limited. Each vendor must
list each item they will be selling and have it ap-

proved. The Health Department will be attend-
ing the Faire and checking booths and food hand-
ling procedures. All groups are to handle all
food items in a safe, sanitary manner, and have
the proper vendor permit as required by Butte
County Health Department guidelines. **Food
booths must include a \$100.00 cleaning depos-
it with their registration fee. Full, partial, or
no refunds of the cleaning deposit will be sent
to vendors within two weeks after the Faire
depending on the condition the space is left in.
Vendors need to take special care that no
cooking oils or vehicle fluids come into con-
tact with the concrete surface.**

Generators: Any food booth planning on using a
generator to supply power must use a "quiet" or
"super quiet" generator. Failure to use appropri-
ate generator may eliminate your participation.

BANNED ITEMS include weapons, smoke
bombs, stink bombs, silly string, and any other
items that the Recreation Supervisor or staff
deems a nuisance or inappropriate. Vendors sell-
ing any of the above items will be banned from
future shows.

IDENTIFICATION OF SPACES: Spaces will
be identified by numbers or by PRPD staff. A
MAP WILL BE POSTED AT THE OFFICE
FOR YOUR INFORMATION.

DISPLAY SET UP: All displays will be set
up between 7:00-9:00am, Saturday. Displays
should be up by 9:00am. ALL DISPLAY
ITEMS ARE TO REMAIN UP UNTIL
4:00PM SUNDAY and be removed by
6:15pm. Early set-up is permitted on Friday,
April 26 after 12:00pm.

ELECTRICAL OUTLETS are lim-
ited.....most outdoor outlets will be used by
food booths.

POSTERS/"FOR SALE" SIGNS, etc. are
all to fit on your table or booth, to be nicely
made and in good taste.

SPACE SIZE: All spaces are outside and
are 10' square with the exception of a few
card table size spaces (approx. 6 x 6). All
vendors must provide their own set up.

PARKING SPACES will be limited and
are first-come first-serve. Paid parking may
be available at the Lutheran Church at the
north end of the park. **Parking is prohibit-
ed on the Skyway.** Staff will not be on duty
Friday night. Staff will be on duty Saturday
night, but PRPD will not be responsible for
theft or damage to displays.

THE PARADE is scheduled for 12 noon
Saturday.
