ICE RINK MAINTENANCE PART-TIME POSITION

THE POSITION

Under supervision of the Recreation Supervisor, and the Ice Rink Manager, the maintence/security is responsible for all areas pertaining to the cleanliness and safety of the ice rink operation and its patrons.

EXAMPLE OF DUTIES

Duties may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Supervision of the ice rink during peak hours, after hours and overnight, if needed.
- Maintence of the outside perimeter of the ice rink and cleanliness of its surrounding areas: including the restrooms, trashcans, and parking lot
- The maintaining of the ice as needed, removing debris, fixing minor holes and scrapes
- Assist the Ice Rink Supervisor on shift in working with difficult patrons if necessary
- Attend training and staff meetings pertaining to the Ice Rink
- Know all safety and emergency procedures concerning the ice rink and its equipment.
- Responsible for general maintenance of ice rink and equipment.
- Evaluate entering patrons for meeting program requirements.
- Enforcement of state and county laws and ordinances and District policies and procedures regarding the health and safety of patrons and staff.
- General help in supervision off all participants and spectators.
- Assist the ice rink staff with the maintence of ice rink activities and events
- Performs other duties as assigned.

DESIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

Knowledge

• Must have knowledge and ability to demonstrate safe and efficient work habits.

Skill

- Skill in handling small tools in a safe and effective manner.
- Skill in handling large tools in a safe and effective manner.

Abilities

- Ability to perform physical labor.
- Ability to work indoors and outdoors.
- Ability to follow oral and written directions.

QUALIFICATIONS

Any combination of education and experience that would likely provide the knowledge, skills, and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge, skills, and abilities would be:

Education/Experience

- One-year experience in a maintenance occupation
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Experience in surveillance is preferred

LICENSE AND CERTIFICATION

Possession of, or ability to obtain and maintain throughout the duration of employment, the following:

- A Class C California driver's license.
- Throughout the duration of employment, maintain an acceptable driving record with five or fewer points as assigned by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Working positions will be standing, sitting and walking approximately 90% of the time.
- Occasionally climbing stairs, ladders and crawling.
- Reaching overhead and stretching, and frequent kneeling and squatting.
- Frequent bending and occasional work on rough, uneven terrain.
- Frequent handling and dexterity.
- Lifting, pushing, pulling and carrying abilities under 100 pounds.
- Must be able to work for extended periods in direct sunlight.
- Must be able to work for extended periods in outdoor winter weather.

MEDICAL EXAMINATION AND FINGER PRINTING

- If required, individual must pass District pre-employment medical examination.
- Individuals must be fingerprinted and meet legal requirements to work as a supervisor with discipline authority over minors.
