The Healing Trauma Through Nature (HTTN) program is a pilot project developed in response to the traumatic effect of the Camp Fire on those residing in the service area of Paradise Recreation and Park District (PRPD). The HTTN program will support partnerships and training to help organizations provide therapeutic outdoor experiences designed to help heal residents of the District. PRPD, in conjunction with our partner organizations, is ready to promote nature-based recreation programs under the umbrella of the HTTN program.

Under the general direction of the District Manager, the HTTN Program Specialist performs responsible, professional outreach, planning, communication, and relationship building/management related to the overall functions and goals of the HTTN program and the District.
