Regular Board of Directors Meeting

March Highlights

Paradise, CA, March 8, 2023 – The Paradise Recreation and Park District (PRPD, District) Board of Directors (Board) conducted its Regular Monthly Meeting on Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at Terry Ashe Recreation Center .

With funding approved from the Butte County Board of Supervisors in June 2022, PRPD has been working with the Town of Paradise to develop a Request for Proposals (RFP) to explore upgraded amenities and recreation along the Yellowstone Kelly Trail. After discussions with the consultant and Staff, the Board authorized the District Manager to finalize an agreement with the American Ramp Company to develop a plan for Trail improvements.

The Board also approved finalizing an agreement with Deer Creek Resources for Geographical Information Systems (GIS) Services and other mapping needs for upcoming planning projects.

The Board entertained a resolution authorizing signatory authority for to the District Manager and Assistant District Manager to apply for FEMA / CalOES Disaster Assistance related to the December – January Atmospheric River damages. Staff requested signatory authority be approved for three years for disaster related assistance. After some clarification from Staff, the Board approved the resolution. The authority will allow for a rapid response following declared disasters.

The Board also approved a Rotary Club of Paradise request for District sponsor ship of an upcoming Vocational Services Job Fair.

Staff presented the Monthly District Report to the Board, which included the final report on the Paradise on Ice Rink. Other monthly updates include the Terry Ashe Recreation Center Solar installation progress, lot line adjustments in Bille Park, and PRPD 75th Anniversary graphics.

After receiving multiple applications, the District awarded four organizations to receive grants under the PRPD Community Recreation Assistance Grant Program to help other organizations provide programs and activities to Ridge Communities.

The next Regular Board of Directors Meeting will be held at Terry Ashe Recreation Center on April 12, 2023, at 6:00 pm.
