Ridge Pools Opening for the Summer Season

Paradise and Concow Pools Opening Soon

Paradise, CA, May 25, 2023 - The Paradise Recreation and Park District (District, PRPD) announces the summer schedule for the Paradise Pool at the Aquatic Park (5600 Recreation Drive, Paradise) and the Concow Pool (11666 Concow Road, Concow) for the summer season. The Paradise Pool will be opening June 10th and the Concow Pool will be opening June 5th.

The season will run through August 12th, with extended classes and adult swim times available into September for the Paradise Pool.

The Paradise Pool features swim lanes, a deep-water slide, and a rock-climbing wall. The pool is open to the public Monday through Saturday, with an Adult Swim starting at 12:15pm, followed by an Open Swim for all patrons later in the afternoon at 1:30pm. The District offers an Aqua Aerobics class Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays in the evenings. Swim lessons take place at the pool in the mornings, which sold out quickly and are in high demand.

The Concow Pool is open to the public Monday through Saturday, with open swim in the afternoons. The Concow Pool features a young children's slide and a snack bar. The District offers Aqua Aerobics classes Mondays and Wednesdays at this site, with swim lessons in the evenings.

For the second year, PRPD will be hosting "Party at the Pool" at the Paradise Pool on June 24th. This will be a movie night on the outdoor screen, featuring *Finding Dory*. More details about this event will be available soon.

Both pools are available for Private Rentals depending on Staff availability. The Paradise Pool also has a rentable space next to it for private parties during Open Swim time. Please call the PRPD Office at 530-872-6393 to reserve or inquire about rentals at either site.
