PRPD Regular BOD Meeting

June Meeting Highlights

Paradise, CA, June 23, 2025 – The Paradise Recreation and Park District (PRPD, District) Board of Directors (Board, BOD) convened for its Regular Monthly Meeting on June 11th, 2025 at the Terry Ashe Recreation Center.

Presentations were given to the Board from Alliance for Workforce Development, which works with the District to fill in maintenance gaps on regular park projects. Also, Director Steve Rodowick gave an account of his submission to CARPD and award received regarding the Community Landmark award for Bille Park.

After opening to public comment and Board discussion, the PRPD 2025-2026 Fiscal Year Final Budget was adopted by the Board of Directors.

Staff presented to the Board a Subgrantee Agreement for approval with SkyCave Art LLC for the Neighbor-to-Neighbor (N2N) Grant, for the purpose of community workshops, events, and art classes. After discussion, the Board approved the Agreement.

Lastly, the District Appropriation Limit for Fiscal Year 2025 – 2026 was adopted by the Board.

The next Regular Board of Directors Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday July 9, 2025, at 6:00 pm at the Terry Ashe Recreation Center. Community members are encouraged to attend.
