Swimming Pool and Lower Bille Park Playground Opening

Post Fire Clean-up Efforts Progress

Paradise, CA, 7/18/19 - The Paradise Swimming Pool (5600 Recreation Drive) will open this weekend on Sunday, July 21, 2019.

Clean-up and repair from the Camp Fire delayed the traditional opening date for the pool. The summer pool schedule will be somewhat abbreviated, but includes youth and adult recreational swimming, lessons, and specialty classes such as kayaking. American Red Cross certified lifeguards and instructors staff the pool.

“The District will continue to provide quality recreational programming to the community, and the opening of the Paradise Pool is an important part of that process” stated Jeff Dailey, Recreation Supervisor for PRPD. The pool has been drained, pressure washed, painted, and tested, and PRPD is ready to welcome the public back.

The District maintains a groundwater well for daily additions to the pool and the District used water from the Paradise Irrigation District (PID) main line to initially fill the pool. Both water sources have been tested and returned clean. The District completes daily testing.

The District worked closely with contractor ATI during the clean-up and repair, and PID and CALFire staff assisted with filling the pool from a nearby hydrant.

Landscaping will be replaced in the fall and the District is initiating plans to rebuild the Aquatic Park Recreation Building destroyed during the Camp Fire.

The District also reports that the Lower Bille Park playground repairs have been completed and will be open this weekend.
