PRPD Board to Review Completed Regional Trails Summary

Paradise, CA, August 11, 2025 – The Paradise Recreation and Park District (District, PRPD) Board of Directors (Board) will review a summary and report from the National Park Service (NPS) at the Regular Board Meeting on August 13th, 2025 at 6:00pm. The report follows a four-year collaboration with PRPD for research and outreach involving a Regional Trails network on the Ridge that connects to other trails in Butte County.

The District received the Rivers, Trails, and Conservation Assistance (RTCA) Grant from NPS in 2021 with the intent of exploring trail expansion ideas within the District and beyond. Trail advisory groups were created and convened, made up of hiking, mountain biking, and equestrian enthusiasts from various areas of expertise, to discuss “dream trails” and trail connectivity between communities.

This project aligns with recovery and outreach efforts Post Camp Fire for rebuilding / expanding recreation opportunities and resilient connected communities. The concluded results of the study are available on the agenda for the August 13th, 2025 Regular Board Meeting.
